

Effectiveness training runs continuously at FAAC

Personal Effectiveness Training runs continuously sponsored by Farmington Area Advisory Council (FAAC), and has for the past four years. But sign-up time is now designated as the first Tuesday of each month.

It is but one of the comprehensive mental health services offered by FAAC, the result of a special grant funded by the State of Michigan Attorney General's Public Health Trust. The program is designed to develop and increase self-effectiveness in four specific areas through a series of learning experiences: communications, personal thought control, relaxation and decision making.

The resulting skills prepare participants to counteract influences of the drug culture, including peer pressure to accept offers of drugs.

The skills aim to enable the individual to create positive relationships, to relax and to make rational, long-range decisions.

Classes are directed by FAAC's professional staff members, who are experienced in counseling and substance abuse treatment, and is offered primarily to local young people and their parents.

The series is conducted in small group settings in the FAAC facility, at 23450 Middlebelt, Farmington Hills.

IN ADDITION to the prevention and education programs provided by FAAC, the organization also offers its "Youth and Parent Counseling Program," and the "Rapline Crisis-Intervention Telephone Service."

FAAC is a non-profit organization supported by public funds and donations.

Housing for FAAC is contributed by the Farmington Public School District. Registrations for the next session of Personal Effectiveness Training to get under way will be taken during regular office hours by calling FAAC, 477-6767, on Tuesday, Nov. 6.

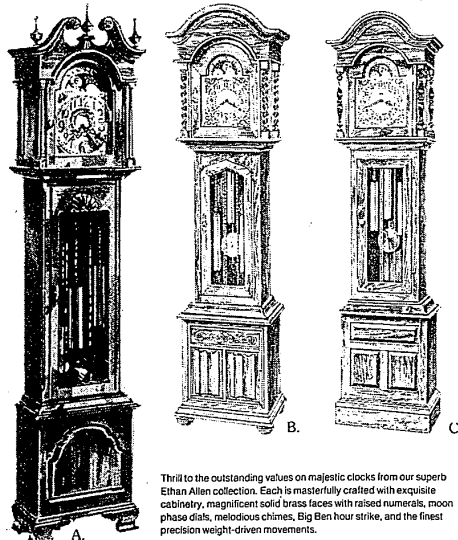
