## Collages exhibited

Thirty-one collages by Chicago artist Robert Nickle will be exhibited at Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum Oct. 28 through Dec. 2.

A native of Saginaw, Nickle studied at the University of Michigan and with Laszlo Mohony-Nagy at the Institute of Design, Chicago.

He has taught drawing and design at the University of Illinois, Chicago Circle, since 1952. His work, generally small in scale and subtle in color, has earned him a reputation for dedication and excellence among the country's community of art instructors.

Nickle's collages are often square and incorporate found materials. He considers them complete only when put into stainless steel frames that he makes.

"I try to keep some 50 or more images in an evolving process all of the time, working on them somewhat as a person playing simultaneous chess games," he said. "When any one of them ceases to demand movement and change, I know that the evolution has stopped and I must make a critical decision — to accept or destroy it."

Museum hours are Tuesday through Sundays from 1-5 p.m. Admission is \$1.50 and guided tours are available by advance notice.

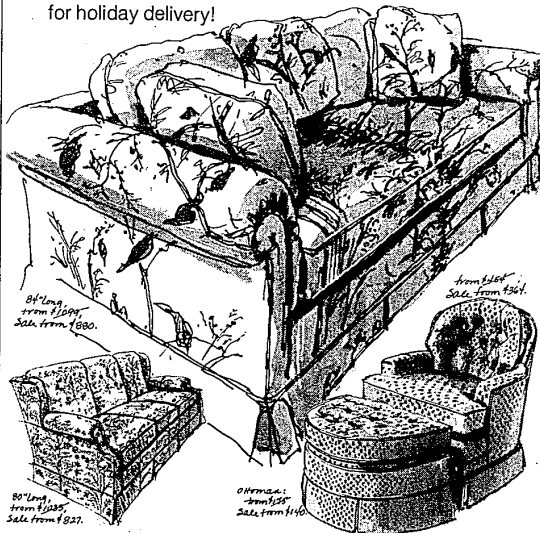

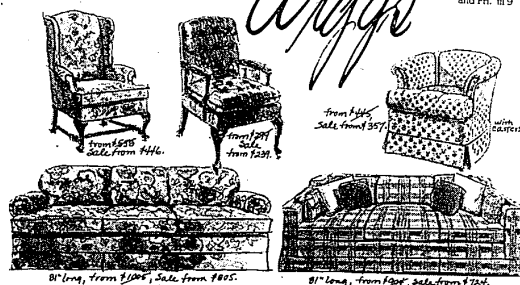
