Guests are welcome at the meeting.

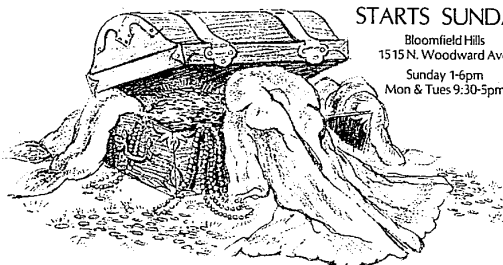

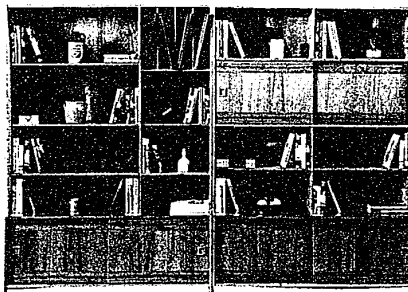
