THURSDAY, NOV. 1

Galerie de Boicourt — Exhibition and sale of original prints and illuminated manuscripts of the Perrin-French Collection of Akron, Ohio, will be at the gallery through Nov. 3. Works in this special show span seven centuries and include Rembrandt and old masters such as Audouin, Goya, Hogarth, Picasso and Whistler. Prices for the prints start at \$10. Thomas C.
