## Levin urges toxic waste site reports

If you think there's a hazardous waste site in your area, report it to U.S. Sen. Carl Levin's office. After two days of hearings in July on hazardous waste management, the Michigan Democrat concluded that there was an inadequate governmental response to reports of chemical contamination that focused on human and animal health problems in Hemlock, Mich. He then decided to develop a plan for residents to provide information to officials through his regional offices about possible toxic sites. "I am inviting the public to contact my regional offices if there is any evidence of a chemical contamination problem which may pose a threat to the health and safety of a community," he said. The reporting system will gather information that may or may not be available to agencies that are responsible for monitoring toxic waste problems. "I can't guarantee that appropriate action will be

"I can't guarantee that appropriate action will be taken to solve all of these problems. However I can guarantee that further governmental inaction in protecting the public from toxic wastes in Michigan will not be due to lack of information," Levin said.

INFORMATION provided by the public will be referred to various state agencies and the federal Environmental Protection Agency. Levin said that will urge the appropriate agency to take prompt and effective action if there is an indication that a health hazard exists.
