## Events varied at Civic Center

What's happening in Detroit's Civic Center area this month while the Detroit Symphony Orchestra is on its European concert tour?

For example, 12 concerts at Ford Auditorium and Cobo Arena, five sports programs, four trade shows and conventions, and more than 20 lunches, dinners and receptions are among the November schedule of events.

Six of the concerts will be held in Ford Auditorium including: SPEBSQSA (Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barbershop Quartet Singing in America) annual Detroit concert, at 8 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 3; The Detroit Concert Band, at 8:20 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 6; Tessie Hill, 8 p.m., Nov. 11; the St. James Baptist Church choir, at 8 p.m., Nov. 25 and 26; and the World of Life Fellowship's "Ring the Bells" concert, at 7:30 p.m., Nov. 30.

Concerts in Cobo Arena this month are: Styx, Thursday, Nov. 1; the Bill Gaither Trio Saturday, Nov. 3; The Jacksons, Sunday, Nov. 4; Bob Marley & the Wailers, Saturday, Nov. 10; Foreigner, Saturday, Nov. 17; and Sammy Hager, Sunday, Nov. 18. All concerts start at 8 p.m.

OTHER ARENA events will include

professional wrestling matches at 8 p.m., Nov. 11 and 25, and professional boxing at 8 p.m., Nov. 15, featuring undefeated Detroit middleweight Dwight Davis.

In Cobo Hall, 6,000 engineers will wrap up their three-day "Autofact II" conference by the Society of Manufacturing Engineers Thursday, Nov. 1. This will be followed by the 1979 International Ski and Winter Sports Show, Friday-Sunday, Nov. 2-4.

At the same time, 2,200 dancers will be competing in the Michigan Square And Round Dance Clubs annual meeting in Cobo Hall Friday-Saturday, Nov. 2 and 3.

Scheduled for Nov. 8-11 is the Michigan Energy Exposition sponsored by the Governor's Committee on Energy Month. Tickets are available at the door.

At the new Hart Plaza, an Easter Seal Society Jog/Walk will be held Sunday, Nov. 4, and the annual "Detroit Aglow Night" when the downtown holiday lights are turned on for the season will open with ceremonies starting at 5 p.m. Nov. 19.
