Theater offers tragicomedy

"Tango," a comiex and absurdly drawn tragi-comedy by the contemporary Polish playwright Slawomir Mrozek, will be the second offering of the current University of Michigan department of the after and drama's Showcase Season, Nov. 14-17, in Trueblood Thearte, Ann Arbor. In "Tango," the playwright explores a multitude of political, social, religious and philosophical is-sues of this century through the disordered lives of three generations of an eastern European family. Both the tragedy and the comedy of the play evolve from the family members' inability to come to terms with each other's differing stands on these issues.

Mrozek was born near Krakow in 1930. Before becoming one of Poland's top playwights he was a cartoonist, short story writer and a writer of children's fiction, which he also illustrated in these earlier efforts, his satirical and political themes

AFTER HIS FIRST play "The Police" was pro

duced in Warsaw in 1958, Mrorek's reputation grew in Poland and throughout the world, where his plays have been performed in various media.

After this play, considered a satirical fable, he moved into the area of the "theater of the aburd" in which "Tango" and several of his one-acts are included.

Though his plays have had varying receipt mortal mortal wide, he is extremely popular in Poland, where the first production of "Tango" in 1956 was agreat success, despite its politically satirical themes in a communist controlled country.
His not being echsored by the government was possibly due to his skillful presentation of these themes in an absurdst fashion. Its previous productions in the United States were off-Broadway in New York and at the Guthric Theatre in Minneapolis.
