

Farmington Beautification efforts recognized by state organization

Once again, Farmington's a beautiful winner.

The city and its beautification committee racked up another round of recognition during the recent Keep Michigan Beautiful awards banquet.

Both the city and the Farmington Beautification Committee won places

in the KMB Hall of Fame. They achieved the recognition by gaining awards for several years.

David Shortt, a senior at Farmington High School, won a distinguished service certificate for his planning and execution of mini-parks in Farmington traffic islands.

The Church of the Latter Day Saints was recognized with a distinguished service award after 40 members helped restore one of the old Quaker cemeteries by removing debris and weeds. They also straightened tombstones and rebuilt a wall. The Farmington Department of Public Service sent

two employees to help with the project.

The Hall of Fame positions won by Farmington's efforts to maintain a clean facade recognized major efforts at renovation and rejuvenation.

The city of Farmington was recognized for its revamping of the central business district. That renovation included about 60 projects in the city which improved the appearance of businesses along Grand River and in the malls.

THE 10-YEAR effort also included work on the mini-parks in the city and for the plantings along Grand River.

The city of Farmington Beautification Committee was recognized in the Hall of Fame for its role as motivator and instigator in many of the city's facelift projects. The committee's public awareness programs, awards program and planting project were cited in the Hall of Fame nomination.
