sion (MCRC) has issued orders in what could prove to be landmark cases in the battle against employment discrimina-

tion.

The two separate cases, argued by Atty. Gen. Frank J Kelley, assure employees working environments free from sexual harassment and hiring policies which guarantee handicappers equal employment opportunities.

IN THE FIRST case Kelley contended, and the MCRC agreed, that employers are required by the Michigan Civil Rights Act to maintain a working environment free from sexually demeaning washel sexical.

The evidence in a case, involving a female employee of a Muskegon market, showed that co-workers, as well as management, repeatedly commented on her sex life, and the sex life of fe-

There was also evidence of males improperly touching female workers and making remarks about the sexual destrability of female customers.
