

U of D to sponsor seminar on sailing

The Troy Hilton Hotel will host a one-night sailing seminar, sponsored by the University of Detroit's continuing education division.

The seminar will include world renowned sail and yacht racing expert Gary Jobson. The seminar will be held at 7:30 p.m. Friday, Nov. 16, at the Hilton Ballroom, 144 Mile Road and Stephenson.

Jobson, the tactician for Ted Turner's six-meter yacht "Tenacious" and his 12-meter yacht "Courageous," will present to Oakland County area sailing enthusiasts some of the most exciting moments in boat racing history.

As the tactician, charged with making all of the critical decisions during the races, Jobson will recreate the experience of the 17-member Turner crew during last August's Fastnet Race in the Irish Sea.

Although he helped guide "Tenacious" to victory in the 306-mile race, the event was marred by tragedy when a sudden gale arose, taking the lives of 18 sailors and forcing the sinking or abandonment of 30 of the 306 yachts that started the race.

Jobson will feature slides and photographs of

that race in his presentation, including some exclusive photos taken by a photographer who was positioned on top of the Fastnet Rock.

Jobson's discussion also will include his experiences aboard "Courageous" during its 1977 victory in the America's Cup, and preview plans for the defense of the America's Cup in 1980.

A member of the U. S. Olympic Yachting committee, Jobson also will offer important insights on our country's chances for yachting medals during the 1980 Olympic Games in Moscow.

Jobson is currently working on his third book — one that instructs beginners in the art of sailing. His lecture will include techniques for beginning sailors, and for sailing in foul weather.

A resident of Annapolis, Md., Jobson also works as a sail racing trainer. He has coached the sport at both the Naval and Merchant Marine academies. A graduate of the New York Maritime College, where he was a three-time All-American sailor, he is the only person to be twice named collegiate Sailor of the Year.

Jobson writes a weekly sailing column in Annapolis, and is a frequent contributor to sailing and yachting magazines. He is author of the "USYRU Sailing Instructor's Manual" and co-author with Ted Turner of "The Racing Edge."
