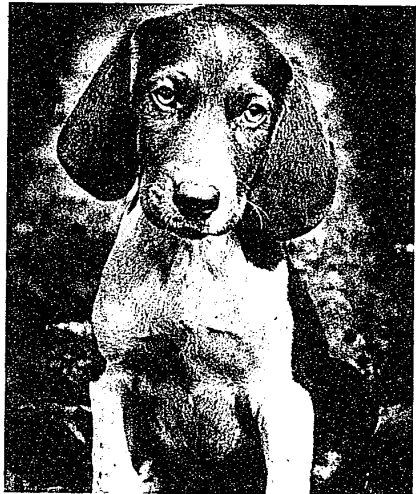

"We're the 18th largest district in the state. In terms of our ranking with the state and the county, we must be competitive with other districts," Shipce said.

"Our feeling is that he's been around for a while, and he's one of the best," he concluded.

Schulman is in his fourth year as superintendent of Farmington schools. Prior to that, he served as assistant su-

perintendent.

Also awarded pay raises last Tuesday were four executive secretaries and 12 supervisors.

School finance director William Prisk explained that the executive secretaries who work for the superintendent and assistant superintendents do not belong to a union because of the confidential nature of their work.

The salaries ranged from \$13,480 for a personnel technician to \$23,530 for the accounting office manager.

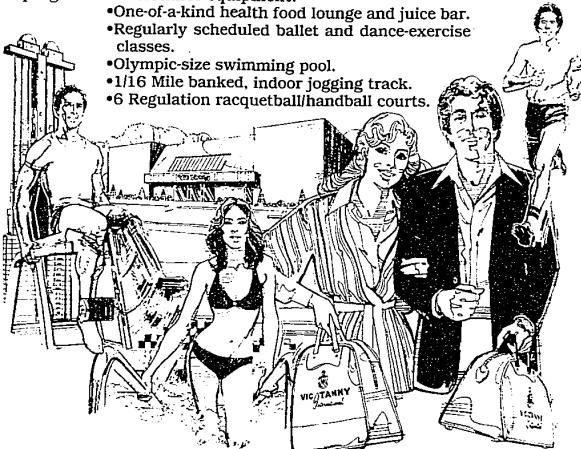
