

Christmas concert will feature ballet

Several Southfield performers will take part when the Oak Park Symphony presents its Christmas concert at 3:30 p.m. Sunday, Dec. 9.

The event is scheduled for the Oak Park High School auditorium, 13701 Oak Park Blvd.

Under the direction of Morris Hochberg, the orchestra will perform with the Contemporary Civic Ballet under the leadership of Rosemarie Floyd.

The program will be all Tchaikovsky. The first number will be "Serenade for Strings" followed by the "Overture Fantasia — Romeo and Juliet."

The orchestra will accompany the ballet in the performance of the last act of "Sleeping Beauty," with guest dancer James Dunn of New York.

Both the symphony and its conductor have been cited for outstanding performances as a community orchestra.

Hochberg heads both the String Department and the Chamber Music Department of Wayne State University

Music School. He is also the conductor of the St. Clair Shores Symphony Orchestra.

Rosemarie Floyd's Contemporary Civic Ballet Company is in its 24th year. They have performed with symphony orchestras in many areas as well as with the Interlochen Arts Academy Symphony and in England.

She holds a Fellowship-Membership with the Imperial Society of London after receiving the Advanced Maestro Cecchetti Diploma, the highest honor in the ballet branch of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dance. Only four other U.S. teachers share this honor.

She received the Headliner's Award as "Woman of the Year" in 1975 from Wayne State University.

James Dunn is presently with the Dennis Wayne Dancers in New York and has danced with the Joffrey Company and the Harkness Ballet.

The new chairman, president of Deutch Realty and Investment Company, is a native Detroitor who attended Mumford High School, Michigan State University, University of Detroit and the University of Detroit Law School.

Deutch devotes some of his busy schedule to helping solve the legal problems of the elderly.
