"I guess it was his belief we would do the job better than anyone else in town." Dalton said.

Designed to promote the city, "My Detroil." toured the area for one year. Positive response prompted "The Road Company" to consider similar contracts with other cities.

SUCH ACCOUNTS have stabilized Dalton. His vagabond days are over.

"I no longer have the desire to run from family and home," the Novi resi-dent said. "Music people are creative and crazy, but I'm as stable as one can be in that form."




