At CMS Berger established a system of "Basic Practice" that includes a dislipline towards improvisational development unique to any other learning institution in the world. With such musi-

cian/instructors as Don Cherry, Roscoe Mitchell, Anthony Braxton and Cecil Taylor, as well as many others, these theories and attitudes have allowed

theories and attitudes have allowed many a skilled musician the opportuni-ty to expand horizons freely. This unique approach toward educa-tion is being brought exclusively to the Ann Arbor area through the residency with Berger.

Berger received a Ph. D. in Heidelberg, Germany. In the U. S. A. during the '60s, he founded the Creative Music Studio in 1971.


