Resident objections spur developer grip

vote) denial was "deliberate, wilful, arbitrary and capricious."

THE TOWNSHIP board denied the rezoning as being in conflict with the master plan, against professional planning advice and that it would set a precedent.

But Sheldon argues the small parcel is unsuitable for residential use because it is next to two major thoroughfares, Kitty-corner to a church and south of an active nursery business.

"We were forced to attend approximately 12 meetings before various township boards, resulting in undue harassment, needless expense, loss of profits and undue delay," said Sheldon

in his court petition.

Township homeowners from West Bloomfield Estates and West Bloomfield Woods subdivisions joined Farmington Hills homeowners from Woodbrook and Rolling Hills subdivisions in objecting to the rezoning.

The township's professional planners are now recommending the entire parcel of land south and west of West Bloomfield Estates be qualified for cluster housing.

But the commissioners decided last week their best course in view of the lawsuit is to consult the township attorney at an executive session before scheduling consideration.
