Red Cross campaigns for blood donations

Since 1974, the Southeastern Michigan Chapter of the American Red Cross has sponsored the Save-A-Life Sunday program.

The program's purpose is to prevent a potentially critical blood shortage. This year the program has been expanded to two days, Dec. 30 and Dec. 31.

"Our blood centers will be open from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on both days," says A.W. Shafer, director of the Southeastern Michigan Red Cross Blood Services.

"We urge everyone between the ages of 17 and 65 in general good health to visit their local blood center."

A regional office is located in Oak

Blood donations, says Shafer, are traditionally reduced during the holiday season because many industries and businesses which supply much of the blood collected for patients' needs are closed during the week between Christmas and New Year's day.

The decrease in donations is complicated by an increase in elective surgery after New Year's.

The goal this year is to collect 1,000 units of blood each day for patients in approximately 75 area hospitals in the five county area which includes Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, St. Clair and Washington.


