## Clergy's role increases

More and more clergy are being included in the health care team of doctor, nurse and social worker, reported Rev. Robert Willoughby, pastoral coordinator of the Michigan Cancer Foundation at a special workshop attended by 25 clergymen last week.

"A total approach to care and comfort for a cancer patient involves treating not only physical and emotional needs, but spiritual needs as well," explained Rev. Willoughby, who introduced a pastoral assessment check-list as a guide to help clergy determine the patient's spiritual beliefs, resources and goals.

The check-list, developed and tested by some 20 chaplains during the past year, identifies such areas as the patient's response to his or her disease, ability to relate to others and to self, and religious affiliations, past and present.

Observations from the list can be drawn to determine the kind of pastoral direction indicated for the chaplain or the patient's personal minister.

"Development of this check-list is a step to the overall process of identifying pastoral ministry today and how this ministry might encompass specific needs of cancer patients," Willoughby said.

"Another purpose of the check-list," he continued, "is to help integrate pastoral care into the total health care team by communicating to team members more clearly the spiritual needs of the patient."
