Dustin Hoffman gives fine performance in 'Kramer vs. Kramer'

The thought of a film about a divorce and an ensuing custody battle brings to mind a host of soapy tearjerkers. "Kramer vs. Kramer ("RG) isn't one of them.

The film takes up the subject, but avoids the cliches. It wends its way through a lot of sentlmental opportunism and emerges clean and unscathed.

Substantial credit for accomplishing this near miracle goes to director and scriptwriter Robert Benton. He adapted Avery Corman's novel, writing controlled scenes that bring out the best in each performer.

Benton is especially good with young Justin Henry, who comes across as a real child (sullen moods and all), and not just an adorable kid in short pants.

THE FILM SHOWS us the evolution of Ted Kramer (Dustin Hoffman) in brief episodes defining his character. He is a confident, even smug, director of a Madison Avenue advertising agency. At home with his wife (Mery Streep) and six-year-old child (Justin Henry) he is still the same self-absorbed executive lindeed, it doesn't occur to him that his family has any life except as satelistes to his star. When Ted's wife, Joanna, leaves him and their son, Billy, it's the beginning of Ted's development as a complete person. His initial reaction is hurt, contrision, and "shell be back" affitting.

When Joanna doesn't return, Ted's reaction changes to anger and irrustration, as he tries to cope with daily problems such as preparing Billy's breakfast, getting him back and forth to school, and generally becoming involved with his life.

Hoffman, in one of his finest screen performances, depicts every aspect of Ted's character. He convinces us of his ego and self-centeredness.

HE VISIBLY DEMONSTRATES his impatience, guilt and anger. And he reveals his change and growth as Billy becomes part of his life, not just an obligation.

When Joann returns after 15 months to seek custody of Billy, it's a major blow to Ted. Joanna's character is the one weakness in the film's development. Streep gives an intense, perceptive performance. However, it can't compensate for lack of scenes that would help to establish her feelings and attitudes. What we learn about Joanna from courtroom testimony is that she has a pulsed be raself to guarded the rentail health and self-esteem, she would like him hack. The story's climax is the courtroom confrontation between Ted and Joanna. It's a dramatic encounter in which two people who once loved each other are forced to tear each other apart for the sake of what is best for the child.

It is a measure of the film's maturity that audiences are moved to sympathize with everyone—there are no villains.

The strength of "Kramer vs. Kramer" is that Ted, Joanna and Billy act and talk like real people, decent people, and we care about what happens to them.
