## Ireland film to be shown

The Community House in Birmingham takes armchair travelers to Ireland Friday-Saturday, Jan. 4-5. Photographer Bill Madson will narrate his color film "The Spell of Ireland."

Curtain time is 8 p.m. on both evenings. Tickets are available in advance at the Community House.

Narrator Madson says, "The spell of Ireland is its people and the intensely vivid color of its countryside, standing aside from all other countries." Madson will take his audience back into the past as he visits Adare Manor's riches and antiquities; The Three Stone, a prehistoric relic; and Ballinlougher Abbey, most historic of all Irish Abbeys (in continuous use for over 750 years).

HIS CAMERA TOURS include the cliffs of the Aran Islands, and the forests of Dun Aengus outlined by miles of stone fences.

The audience will visit the famed Waterford glass factory and follow each step required to convert raw materials into glass art. A tour of Dublin takes viewers to Merrion Square and through Georgian houses. There will also be a look at the Royal Dublin Society Spring Show, where exhibits of show horses and carriages, farm contests, horse jumping and performances by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police take place.

Preceding the travel film program, the Community House will serve dinner featuring Irish foods. Dinner is served at 6 p.m.

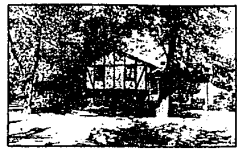

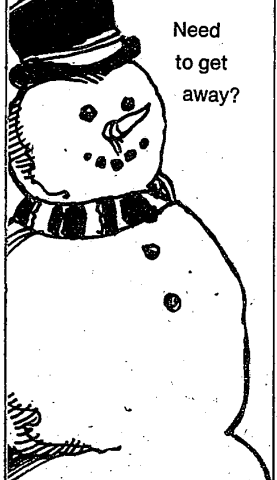
