Man accused of molesting neighborhood children

The arrest of a local man on charges of committing sexual crimes against neighborhood youths has shocked residents of Pleasant Lake Highland subdi-

wision.

Ralph W. Bryle of West Bloomfield,
grew up and lives in the Pleasant
Lake Highland subdivision. He has been
arraigned on charges of committing

sexual crimes against three neighborhood youths over a five-year period.
Charged with two counts of third-degree criminal sexual conduct, Bryle stood mute at his Tuesday arraignment at 8th District Court. He was released on personal recognizance and a \$10,000 bond was posted on each count.
A 9 a.m. examination is set for next Jan. 24 before 48th District Court Judge David Breck.

Although Bryle was charged with a five-year involvement with neighborhood youths who are now 15, 16 and 17 years old, Oakland County Sheriff Johannes F. Spreen said, "It appears there may be others."
