Hawk spikers triumph

Donna Sandford served up eight straight points to water up a two-game sweep for Farmington Harris, 15-12 and 15-5, over Waterford Mott in a volleyball match played Monday at Harrison.

Sandford took over the serve for the Hawks with her team ahead 8-5, in the second contest. She served the rest of the way to help the Hawks to their second win in the Western Six League against two losses.

The victory was a boost for Harrison, which had suffered setbacks in its two previous outings. Last Saturday, the Hawks competed in the Schoolcraft Invitational volleyball tournament. The team failed to win any of their eight games in their pool.

Last Wednesday, Harrison hosted Plymouth Canton and lost in three games. The Hawks won the opener, 15-8, but dropped the second, 16-15. They led in the third and deciding game, 14-10. But Canton rallied and eventually took the match, 16-14.

Inability to keep their serves in-bounds cost Harrison the win in the match. Despite the poor performance against Canton and at Schoolcraft, the Hawks got sterling performances from spiker Linda Bahe. Ann Corbett had a good day serving at Schoolcraft.

IN OTHER VOLLEYBALL action Farmington came up short in its match with the defending Inter Lakes League (ILL) champion, Livonia Stevenson, as the Falcons lost, 15-4, 15-11, Monday at Stevenson.

"I don't think we're quite ready for them," Farmington coach Ron Short said. "I think we tried a bit too hard. The girls may have been too up for the match."

"Luckily, we meet them again. Hopefully, we'll be ready for them. This time, we just couldn't control our passing."

Passing was again the problem at the Schoolcraft Invitational for Farmington. But the team fared much better than Harrison, winning six of eight games but narrowly missing the tournament playoffs.
