Swim records fall

Chuck Gabrean, representing the Farmington-based Michigan Stingray Swim Association, shattered a long-standing state Amateur Athletic Union record for the 13- and 14-year 50-yard freestyle last Saturday at the Class A Bulldog Aquatic Club swimming meet.

His winning time of :22.75 erased the previous standard of :22.93 established by Russ Deherder in 1975.

More than 500 of the state's best young swimmers attended the three-day AAU competition held in the Schoolcraft Community College pool Friday through Sunday.

In addition to his state record, Gabrean stroked to four more first place finishes, including a near miss of a state record in the 100-yard with a time of :49.7. His efforts earned him the meet's high-point trophy for the 13-14 boys' age group.

KATY HARNDEN of the Stingrays finished third in the 13-14 girls' 200 fly with a time of 2:21.5. Teammate **Jill Andries** placed fourth in the 100 breast stroke (1:13.05) in the same age group.

Chris Leslie and **Kirstin Kinsman** each added a sixth place finish to the Stingrays' total. Swimming in the boys' 11-12 group, **Leslie** finished the 100 butterfly in 1:07.79. **Kinsman**, working in the girls' 15-18 group, logged a 2:21.5 in the 200 fly.

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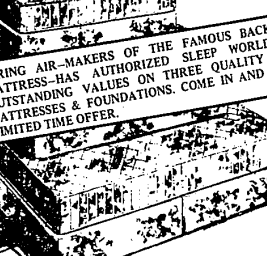

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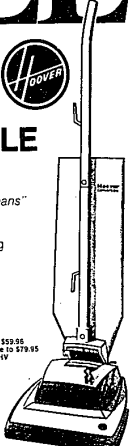
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
