Things may be going better with cocaine

A University of Michigan study indicates that marijuana use among American high school students may be leveling off for the first time in more than a decade.

At the same time, cocaine use among high school students is increasing at an accelerating rate, and the use of inhalants has also been rising.

The authors — U-M social psychologists Lloyd Johnston, Jerald Bachman, and Patrick O'Malley — note that since 1975, daily or near-daily use of marijuans had been rising at an alarming rate, nearly doubling from 6 percent in 1975 to 11 percent in 1978.

The U-M researchers report that although marijuana use increased appreciably during the last half o the 1970s, the proportion of young people going behond marijuana to other illicit drugs has not changed appreciably over the same interval—a fact which tends to refute the notion that marijuana involvement necessarily leads to the use of other drugs.

IN THE CLASS of 1975, some 26 percent report-ed illicitly using one or more other drugs during the year; in the class of 1979 that number was only two percentage points higher. But for specific illicit drugs, more dramatic changes have been taking


