A recreational vehicle tour of the Big Island of Hawaii is a practical way for honeymooners to enjoy an exotic setting.

The two glamorous resort areas of Hilo and Kona are available for special celebrations, and the many camp sites on the island are available for low-cost travel on a more private level.

Mini-homes and compact cabovers are available from Aloha Camper Rentals and Beach Boy Campers, but the biggest outfit

with a wide assortment of campers is Holo-Holo Campers, run by the Gordon Morse family.

Morse will include a map of the island and information about county, state and national parks. Campgrounds on the Big Island are more primitive than on the mainland. You don't need reservations and you'll get only very basic facilities.

What you will get is the authentic, romantic Big Island at your doorstep. Campgrounds are available on the coast near Hawaii Vol-

canos National Park, in the lush country north of Hilo, in the historic north Kona side of the island, and on the very slope of Mauna Kea.

The island of Hawaii is not like Oahu or Maui. Don't expect tropical foliage everywhere. It is the top of a very high volcanic mountain and its sights range from cattle ranches, orchid farms and nut factories to live volcanic action.

This is the same river that flows through the Alamo, and you can visit the famous fort a few streets away from the river. You can also climb the Tower of the Americas, built for the 1968 HemisFair, or tour the 17th century Spanish missions that line Mission Trail out of town.

There are many such practical, tourist-oriented things to do in this southern Texas city, but those associated with the river may be what you remember best.

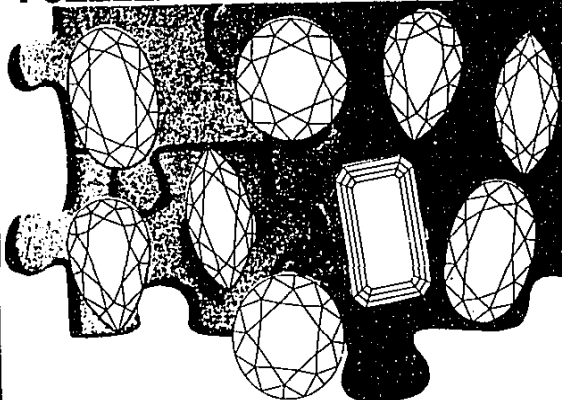
If you visit San Antonio in April, you can enjoy the fun and games of the fiesta, which has all the markings of a springtime Mardi Gras. For four nights, there is food and beer and dancing and entertainment during Nights in Old San Antonio.

Flowered floats glide on the river during the river festival. During fiesta, or on any ordinary spring night, you may stroll down the Paseo del Rio past the ships, restaurants, night clubs and outdoor cafes that line the narrow river.

This river was once described derisively as a "sewer running through the warehouse district." But it is now a traveler's delight, and new hotels are sprouting on its banks.
