Wanted: One snowfall

Lack of snow has forced cancellation of nearly all the events scheduled for the West Bloomfield Parks and Recreation department. But the P&R hasn't given up yet.

This weekend will be winter's last chance to provide snow for the P&R department's "Operation Snowflake". The events have been postponed from last weekend because of lack of both snow and ice.

Events from Operation Snowflake include a moonlight ski hike Feb. 9, a fish-

ing derby Feb. 9, a skate, pass and shoot contest Feb. 10, and a snow sculpture contest Feb. 10.

Preregistration is required for all events, no later than 5 p.m. Thursday. A decision will be made Friday morning on the weather condition and all those registered will be contacted.

The moonlight hike will be at Snow Gulch starting at 8 p.m. It is planned as a family cross country activity. The fee is \$1 for adults and 50 cents for children 12 and under.

The Apple Island Snow Chase, a men's cross country ski race, is open to men, women and youths. Trophies will be awarded to winners and medals given to those who place second, third or fourth in 10 age groups. It will start at 1 p.m., with a \$3.50 fee for adults and \$2.50 for youth 17 and under.

Both the ice fishing derby and the skate, pass and shoot contest will be held on a cleared section of Middle Straits Lake. Awards will be presented to youths in different age groups for the first, most and biggest fish caught in the derby. The fee is \$1.50 and each competitor must bring his own equipment.

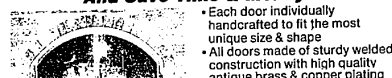
The skate, pass and shoot contest is open to those 7-16 years old. The fee is \$1.50.

In the snow sculpture contest, awards will be given to the sculptors that display the most color, are most unusual or are the largest. They may be erected in any site in the township, although public sites are suggested. The fee is \$2 — winners will be announced Monday, Feb. 11.
