

# Feldpausch stars in poignant play

The Theatre Guild of Livonia-Redford continues its 26th season with a production of Peter Nichols' "A Day in the Death of Joe Egg". Shows are Feb. 15, 16, 22, 23, 24, 29 and March 1 at 15133 Beech Daily, just south of Five Mile, in Redford Township.

Curtain is 8:30 p.m. for all performances except Feb. 24, which is a 2:30 p.m. matinee. Admission is \$4.

Discounts are available to students and senior citizens on opening night and the Sunday matinee. Seating is limited and reservations are recommended. Call 255-2547.

It is a comedy play about a couple with a 10-year-old incurably spastic daughter who is referred to as "Joe Egg".

It has been described as a remarkable play about a nightmare all women must have dreamed at some time, and most men — living with a child so helplessly crippled as to be, as the mother says brutally, "a human persimmon".

"For all that, it is a comedy, both funny and touching. The author implies that, over the years, explaining to others how one lives with such a situation becomes a kind of set party piece. This, savagely exaggerated, is the

form of the play — a recital, interspersed with fake, imitations and tap dances, about life with "Joe Egg".

After a long run in London, "Joe Egg" opened on Broadway in 1968, starring Albert Finney as the father, Brian. Dale Feldpausch of Farmington Hills assumes this role in the Guild production. Feldpausch teaches drama part time at Schoolcraft College and directed "The Real Inspector Hound" there last fall.

Rehearsals are progressing under the direction of Ronald Worsley, who received his Ph.D. in speech and theater from Wayne State University and is theater director at Henry Ford Community College in Dearborn. This is Worsley's fourth directing assignment for the guild. Assisting him is Lesa Sweeney, a graduate of Livonia's Bentley High School, who received the school's honor award for dramatics in her senior year.

Producer Mary O'Connell of Plymouth came to the guild as a "stage mother" during "The King and I" in 1969. Since then, she has served on the board of directors in several offices, including president, and worked on approximately 40 shows. She is a registered nurse, mother of five daughters, and a grandmother.
