## Mayall heads blues concert

British bluesman John Mayall will appear in concert with special guest Chicago blues guitarist Luther Allison on Thursday, Feb. 21, at Ann Arbor's Second Chance.

Mayall, guitarist/vocalist/harmonist, is recognized as the "father of British Blues" after leading a series of powerhouse groups known as the Bluesbreakers through the late '60s and early '70s.

Eric Clapton, ex-Rolling Stones guitarist Mick Taylor and Fleetwood Mac bassist John McVie are among alumni who have graduated from Mayall's Bluesbreakers.

Over the last two decades Mayall has recorded 30 albums.

Allison has been described as a cross between B.B. King and Jimi Hendrix, merging the traditional and the contemporary, the blues with rock and roll.
