Film on Galapagos shown at Cranbrook

The islands that fascinated Charles Darwin will be the topic of a film to be shown at 2:45 and 3:45 p.m., Feb. 23, at Cranbrook Institute of Science. "The Galapagos: Darwin's World Within Itself" describes these islands, which are inhabited by a bizarre array of plants and animals found nowhere else. In 1835, Darwin visited the Galapagos Islands to catalog evidence that led to the concept of evolution through natural selection. The film is free with museum admission of \$2.50 for adults, \$1.50 for students and senior citizens. Also included in museum admission that day are planetarium demonstrations featuring black holes at 2, 3, 4 and 7:30 p.m. and observatory demonstrations from 8:30 to 10 p.m. For more information, call 645-3200. 
