• Kendallwood argues that traffic through Tulipwood was becoming unbearable when the street was opened. They argued that drivers take Tulipwood during rush hour to avoid the 12 Mile-Farmington Road intersection.

 Kendallwood residents also argue that parents driving children to Wood-dale school create a traffic jam each morning.

Farmington Green resident, on the other hand, find it difficult to drive their children to school. With Tulip-wood closed, parents are forced to use 12 Mile to get to Wooddale.

Access to the subdivisions through Tulipwood for ambulances and police is hindered by the closing, Farmington Green residents also argue.

While Lange might be anxious to hear arguments once again, veteran councilman take a less optimistic view.




