Temporary repairs to the crumbling sewer line near the Oakland and Macomb County border should prevent any service interruptions for the 300,000 residents affected, according to an Oakland County official.

"Things are probably in pretty good shape right now," said Donald Ringler, the county DPW's severand water manager. Ringler attended a two-hour closed meeting last week with Detroit officials on the status of the Oakland-Macomb interceptor sew-

er.
"They (Detroit Water and Sewerage Department
officials) don't expect any interruption of service,"
said Ringler, who agreed that service culbacks are
"very remote."

CRUMBLING in the sewer line — which carries sewage from northeastern Oakland (including Avon Township and part of West Bloomfield Township) and southwestern Macomb to the Detroit sewage

and southwestern Macomb to the Detroit sewage treatment plant — was discovered in late January. Before smaller auxiliary sewer lines were installed in the damaged pipe earlier this month, DWSD was considering diverting sewage into the Clinton River and Lake St. Clair. Officials from Oakland and Macomb counties were told last week, however, that it will be unnecessary to divert sewage into area waters. Health officials from each county and Michigan Department of Natural Resources officials also attended the meeting.

include: three pipes installed inside the damaged 300-foot section of the sewer line; the ground over the damaged area has been frozen with liquid nitrogen and abrine solution; wells are being installed in the area to de-water the ground.

Ringler said Macomb County has retained a private engineering firm from Baltimore to Investigate the trouble-plagued sewer interceptor. A different Macomb County portion of the same sewer line collapsed in July 1978, and raw sewage was pumped into Lake St. Clair.

Ringler said Oakland County has not joined with Macomb in hirring the Baltimore firm but may consider doing so late this week.

SO FAR, Deteriol officials have been mum on the cost of both temporary and permanent repairs.

"We attempted to get an estimate out of Detroit," said Ringler. "But they would give us none or din thave one at this time."

These temporary measures have been taken, fingler said.

"Three pipes have been installed inside the damaged 304-0ot section of the sewer line, which is 60 feet underground. These temporary steel casing

A BYPASS system to remove the flow from the damaged 12-foot diameter pipe may be completed by mid-April, according to Ringler. Work has start-ed on the bypass pipes and a temporary pumping

station.

Once the flow is removed from the damaged interceptor, the DWSD's hired contractors can get inside the pipe and figure out why it crumbled, Ringler said.

SuburNan officials have been critical of Detroit's choice of contractors for the sewer repair. The privacy contractor, Walbridge Aldinger Co., of Detroit, retained the Michigan Sewer Construction Co., of Southfield, which built the sewer during the early 1970s.

DWSD is planning to hire its own "independent expert" to investigate one the temporary repairs are made.

Regarding the investigations, Ringler said, "I don't think there's anything really concrete yet. Thingler was one of a few officials allowed on the site of the damaged interceptor south of 15 Mile Road in Sterling Heights.
