Goldie Adler, prominent book reviewer and lecturer, will reveal her culinary secrets for patron ticket-holders of Congregation Shaarey Zedek's "Women's World 1979" at 1 p.m. Monday, March 5.

Demonstrations, recipes and samples of many unusual desserts will be part of the program in the Morris Adler Hall.

Complimentary copies of Mrs. Adler's new booklet, "A Baker's Dozen of Goldie's Gourmet Goodies" will be distributed to all donor supporters.

Mrs. Adler, wife of the late Rabbi Morris Adler, was born and raised in New York and came to Detroit 39 years ago. An organizer of the Women's Division of the Detroit Round Table of Catholics, Protestants and Jews, and of the Woman's Division of the Jewish Welfare Federation, she also serves on many boards of educational and philanthropic organizations.

She is on the boards of Shapero School of Nursing, Women's Guild of Sinai Hospital, the Southfield Arts Council and Brandeis University, and is a past president of Hadassah.

She has been the recipient of many awards including the Myrtle Wreath Award, the Eleanor Roosevelt Humanities Award, the Lady of Mercy Award from Mt. Carmel Mercy Hospital, and in 1974, the Solomon Schechter Award from the Jewish Theological Seminary.

Following Mrs. Adler's program, "Woman's World 1979" will feature a second fund-raising program sponsored by the Sisterhood.

Guest speaker at the 10 a.m. event on Wednesday, Apr. 4 will be Dr. Alice Ginott, noted psychologist-psychiatrist and wife-partner of the late Dr. Haim Ginott.

Her topic will be: "The Art of Loving Communication."

The all-day event will open with a

continental breakfast, and will include boutiques, a white elephant sale, luncheon and other activities.

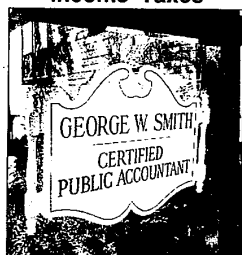

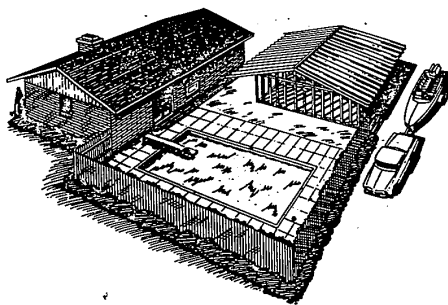
