

Falcons need 2 OTs to whip Central, 71-63

North Farmington finished its regular season on a sour note, as it dropped a 68-54 decision to Northwest Suburban League champion Westland John Glenn last Friday.

The Raiders got off to a quick start early in the season, winning eight of their first nine games. But they have been having their problems of late, as they suffered their fourth straight loss against Glenn.

North is 12-7 on the year, with six of its losses coming in NSL play. The Raiders finished with a 4-6 league record.

Against the Rockets, who are 16-4 overall and 10-0 in the conference, North stayed close throughout the contest but were unable to take control. The score was tied after one period, 12-12, but John Glenn took a 30-27 half-time lead.

Glenn increased that margin to 46-40 after three periods, and North couldn't catch up.

The Raiders poor free throw shooting hurt their chances for an upset victory, as they managed to hit on only six of 15 opportunities. Many of the misses came on the front end of one-and-one

Attempts, thus taking away a possible two points.

The state district playoffs are next for North, and it will be one of the favorites to win the crown. Its first contest will be against Walled Lake Central on Tuesday at 8:30 p.m. The toughest of the competition in the tournament field will be Millford Lakeland, which will play the winner of the North-Central contest. Farmington, Farmington Harrison, and Walled Lake make up the rest of the district, which will be played at Western.

Mike Bryant pumped in 29 points to lead Western to a 71-65 win over Harrison Friday at Western.

The loss ended Harrison's regular season, as the Hawks fell to 6-14 overall and 3-4 in the Western Six League. Western is 5-15 and 3-4 in the conference.

The contest was tied at 31 after one half, but Western blitzed Harrison with a 24-7 advantage in the third quarter. The Hawks rallied in the final period, outscoring Western 27-16 in the stanza, but couldn't overtake them.

Brad Herremans, Dave Turnquist, and Scott Hendries combined for 47 points for Harrison, with Herremans scoring 18, Turnquist, 16, and Hendries, 12.

"I think it was a case of us looking past this game to the districts," Harrison coach Mike Teachman said after the loss. "Western had some kind of presentation at halftime, and that seemed to fire up their kids in the second half."

Andover outswims S-L

Southfield-Lathrup ended its dual-meet swimming season with a 92-72 loss to Bloomfield Hills Andover last Wednesday at home. Lathrup finished with a 6-7-1 overall record.

Lathrup's Roberts brothers, Chuck and John, each won two individual events. Chuck, a senior, won the 200-yard individual medley (2:14.4) and the 100-yard butterfly (1:01.2). John, a junior, took the 50 freestyle (23.0) and the 100 freestyle (51.0).

Lathrup took two other firsts: Todd Winston compiled 237.50 to win the diving event, and Dave Bowser was clocked in 1:54.0 to win the 200 freestyle.

Harrison will be at Western again Thursday to take on the winner of the Farmington-Western game in the second round of the district playoffs. Harrison has a bye in the first round.

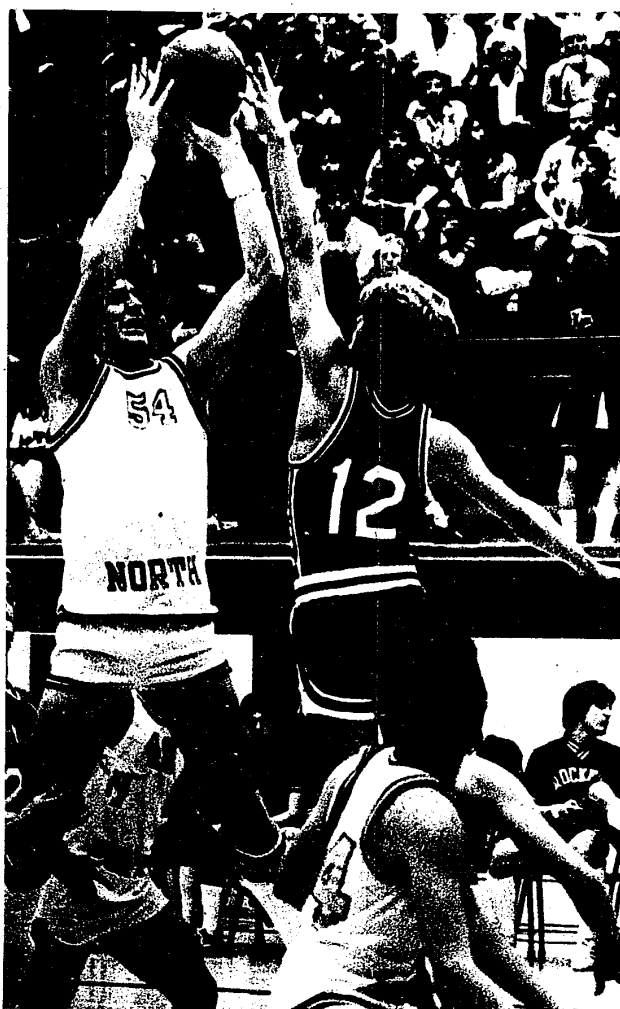

Conference meets next for Farmington tankers

North Farmington can capture its seventh-straight Northwest Suburban League swimming championship this week if it can finish first in the conference meet Thursday and Friday at Redford Union High.

Coach Pat Dublie's North team is having one of its better seasons with a 10-1 overall record and a 5-0 mark in the NSL. Last Thursday, North closed out its dual-meet season with a 120-52 win over NSL foe Redford Thurston.

Conference meet preliminaries begin at 7 p.m. Thursday and the finals are set for 7 p.m. Friday.

Farmington High's swim team will be shooting for its second-straight Inter Lakes League crown at the league meet Thursday and Friday at Livonia Stevenson. Farmington has lost two dual meets to Stevenson, but the Falcons could win the title by winning the league meet.

ILL meet prelims start at 5 p.m. Thursday. Finals begin at 7:30 p.m. Friday.

Farmington Harrison will host the Western Six League meet on Thursday and Friday. Prelims start at 4 p.m. Thursday. Finals get underway at 7:30 p.m. Friday.

IN THE North-Thurston meet, North's Keith Winston won two individual events — the 50-yard freestyle (23.5) and the 100 freestyle (52.1) — and swam a leg on the 400 free relay (with Brian Manderville, Gerry Highley and Phil Holcomb), which won with a time of 3:57.4.

North's 200 medley relay (Kirk Knock, David Paul, John Spangenberg and Joe Dumas) won with a 1:50.7 clocking.

Farmington finished its dual-meet season last Thursday with a 111-61 victory over Walled Lake Central in the Inter Lakes League. Farmington is 8-6 overall.

Farmington, which won nine of the 11 events, got a double win from Dave Uzelac, who took the 50 free (23.4) and the 100 butterfly (58.6).

Both Farmington relays won. The 200 medley crew (Dave Kieley, John Ehrman, Andy Kile and Pat Cavanaugh) was timed in 1:53.2. The 400 freestyle team (John Uzelac, Dave Uzelac, Bob Carruthers and Kieley) went 3:37.5. Farmington diver Dennis Antishin won that event with 222.75 points.

Earlier last week, Farmington downed non-league Livonia Churchill, 174-128.

Carruthers won two individual events, the 200 free (2:00.3) and the 100 free (53.5). Farmington's 200 medley relay team (Kieley, Ehrman, Kile and Mark Wubben) won with a time of 1:55.1.

Harrison finished with an 0-16 overall mark and an 0-8 mark in the Western Six after its 111-54 loss to Walled Lake Western last Thursday.

Harrison's John Roden won two events, taking the 200 free (1:50.8) and the 500 free (5:05.6). Al Babcock won the 200 IM (2:22.6), and Al Laforest won the 100 fly (57.9).
