

Catholic league launches drive

March is membership month for the League of Catholic Women, during which men and women of all faiths throughout the metropolitan Detroit area are invited to join or renew their memberships in Detroit's oldest social service organization.

Founded in 1905, the 8,000-member League of Catholic Women operates five social service agencies in Detroit and four Bargain Counter resale shops in the tri-county area.

Barat Human Services is a coordination of residential and counseling services for disturbed adolescent girls and families. Casgrain Hall is a low-cost residence for 120 single men and women of limited means. Casa Maria is a community center in the Tigertown area of Detroit which provides recreation, counseling, crafts, tutorial and pre-school programs. Project Transition is a total rehabilitation program for women offenders; and TASC is a new employment training program for the jobless.

According to League President Marilyn Lundy, of Grosse Pointe, the membership dollars are used as seed money to help generate large grants and funds for league-sponsored agencies. She added that membership revenue also serves as cash flow to pay bills before reimbursement from funding agencies, for special needs in the agencies and as an outright subsidy to Casgrain Hall.

Mrs. Ralph Rays, of Dearborn Heights, is chairwoman of the 1979 membership drive. She has recruited women from each parish in the Catholic Archdiocese of Detroit to serve as parish directors in the annual campaign.
