Inflation Still Long Range Woe

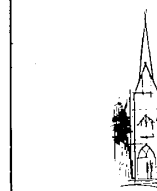
ANN ARBOR Restrictive monetary and fiscal policies are beginning to cool America's long overheated economy - but additional measures will be necessary for long-range control of inflation, according to Paul W. McCracken, chairman of the President's Council of Economic Advisers.

McCracken, currently on leave as Edmund Ezra Day university professor of business administration at the University of Michigan, acknowledges in the November issue of Michigan Business Review that it has been difficult to halt an inflation "allowed to run for so long - now almost four years."

"This long-sustained inflation will, of course, respond to the therapy of basic policies to cool off overheated economic conditions," McCracken writes. "About that we can be completely confident. It may, however, take somewhat longer than if we were dealing with a temporary aberration on the top side of the economy's basic growth path."

HE NOTED THAT demand for output (in current prices) appears to be decelerating and that corporate after-tax profits have been relatively flat since the turn of the year. "It seems probable that pressures on profit margins will continue to be heavy," he noted.

McCracken also observed that the latest survey by the U-M Survey Research Center revealed a substantial decline in consumer sentiment - which usually indicates a shift in discretionary spending. "Now this evidence obviously does not add up to an end of our inflationary problems," the presidential adviser cautioned. He suggested some steps which should be taken.

Dems Set Local, State Sessions

County conventions Dec. 5, 6 and 7 and then district conventions Dec. 12 and 13 will lead up to a state convention Jan. 17 and 18.

Newest LNB Bond Grows Big

A new guaranteed growth-savings bond that doubles its value in less than 14 years will be introduced by Livonia National Bank Dec. 1, according to Edwin D. Dougherty, president.

Livonia National Bank, first in this area to offer the new bonds, will make them available in maturity value denominations of \$25, \$50, \$100, \$500, \$1,000 and \$5,000.

"Priced at one-half the maturity value to double in a term of 13 years 316 days, the \$25 par value bond will be sold for \$12.50, the \$50 bond for \$25, etc.," says Dougherty.

The new bonds will double their value at maturity by continuously compounding a 5% annual rate previously reserved for savers with high balance savings accounts.

"The new bonds make the 5% guaranteed interest rate available to even the smallest saver," says Dougherty.

New guaranteed growth-savings bonds will be redeemable at the bank, at the full 5% interest rate, on each three month anniversary of the issue date, or within 10 days thereafter.

Because the new bonds can be registered in a name other than that of the purchaser, without any red tape, Dougherty is optimistic about them as a gift value.

Times and places of the local conventions will be announced by their local chairmen as soon as arrangements are made.

SPECIFICALLY, the conventioners will be asked to decide whether the party should propose to the Michigan Legislature a nine-point recommendation for changes in state and federal laws.

Such liberal goals as a presidential primary, the 18-year-old vote, elimination of voter residency and property qualifications, and tax credits for political contributions are among the commission's suggested changes.

Others are one-man, one-vote principles at all levels of party decision making, severe tightening of campaign financing and candidate expenditure reporting, and establishment of a party grievance appeals committee with fact-finding authority and power to recommend disposition to the state central committee or conventions.

Elimination of voter registration requirements is included, to go along with the public political action sector. Allocation of free television and radio prime time for candidates seeking top federal and

state offices is the ninth major commission proposal.

THE EFFORT follows what is believed to be a first-ever state-wide study aimed at political reform. It is independent of, but closely coordinated with, a current national study.

The Michigan Democratic Party Political Reform Commission that put forth the proposal is chaired by Dr. Haber, economist and advisor to governors and presidents, along with former Democratic State Chairman Sander Levin, who is now Michigan Senate minority leader.

The national effort is being chaired by Senator George S. McGovern, who led faction of peace Democrats in a run for the presidential nomination of that party in 1968.

THE MICHIGAN commission of 102 members spent 10 months preparing their report, which is billed as an attempt to "adjust to the times."

Levin said its thrust is "to get everyone into American democracy... with all sides to have equal political power... and a fair chance."
