Longest-running show closing down

The Theater of the Arts production's version of "I Do! I Do!" currently playing at the Machus Red Fox in Birmingham has become the longest running two-person dinner-theater show in the Detroit area.

The musical comedy opened last September, and when the curtain falls Friday, March 30, the show will have been playing for more than 25 weeks.

Claudia Hill, one half of the show's energy, said "the show needs a breather, but it could be introduced in a year or so. I think this shows a growing

interest in theater in the Detroit area. More people are being exposed to live theater than ever before."

The Red Fox dinner-theater will go dark until June 15 when it re-opens for the summer with the Cook-Moore comedy "Good Evening."

Still showing around Metro Detroit are Theater of the Arts productions "Two for the Sessim," Saturdays at Alvaro's in Royal Oak, and "The Good Doctor," Fridays and Saturdays at Mr. Mac's Stable in Dearborn.
