

Don't choose a fabric that will overwhelm the area in which it is to be used. In a very bright space, avoid fabrics with shocking or vibrant colors, or those with a sheen to their texture. They will cause a glare that is most unpleasant.

In dark places, dark colors will lose tone and subtlety. They will be much too somber.

If the fabric has a print, always buy more than you think you will need. The more elaborate the print, the more fabric will be needed.

It is a talent to see a nondescript wall or piece of furniture and visualize texture, pattern and color enhancing it. All it takes is an open mind and a love of patten and color.
