Road commission will be ready for Super Sunday

What will happen if a snowstorm hits mid-Oakland County prior to the 1982 Super Bowl football game in the Pontiac Silverdome?

And even if there isn't a snowstorm, how will road officials handle traffic? The Oakland County Road Commission says it will be ready for whatever happens. Managing Director John L. Grubba said his staff is preparing emergency ice and snow removal plans for three sets of circumstances — "a storm prior to the event, a storm during the event and a storm after the event."

The National Football League championship will be decided Jan. 24 that year. Major snowstorms commonly hit southeast Michigan the fourth week of January.

"We will make every effort to insure fast and efficient ingress and egress to the stadium area in the event of a major storm," said Grubba.

"We consider weather forecasting as vital, and we'll attempt to make special arrangements for this service to provide the most accurate and timely information. We will make arrangements to secure equipment and manpower in addition to our own, in case they become necessary. We will coordinate with other affected agencies."

"Regarding construction and reconstruction, we have reviewed a wide range of improvements in the stadium area," said Grubba, adding that a staff has been directed to develop two separate but coordinated construction proposals.

One would be for county roads, which the road commission administers, and the other for state trunklines.

State trunklines in the stadium area include I-75, M-59, Telegraph Road, Woodward Avenue, Highland Road, Auburn Road, Lapeer Road, Dixie Highway and Rochester Road.

A \$4 MILLION plan for county roads — including an M-59 pedestrian overpass just west of Opdyke Road and traffic flow improvements — is being worked on by the road commission's planning and traffic services departments, Grubba said.

"We will consider improvements to the state trunkline system. We will not be constrained by financial factors in our study of state highway needs."

"We are also mindful that construction and reconstruction projects will be necessary to serve not only the event, but also to serve developments that are going on in the stadium area — such as four new hotels — which will present a permanent and continuing demand on the road system."
