Performers bring shows to campus

The Lion Company will begin a season of presentations in May on the campus of Oakland Community College in Auburn Heights (OCC-AH).

The company is a semi-professional troupe of actors and technicians whose aim is to present highest quality productions of equally high plays.

Its repertoire runs the gamut from hit Broadway musicals like "The Fantasticks" to the electrifying drama of Albee's "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?" from the dark visions of Williams' "Cat on a Hot Tin Roof" to the delightfully light-hearted world of Shakespeare's "Twelfth Night."

The company was one of 20 groups from throughout Michigan invited to participate in the Michigan Council for the Arts first annual Congress of the Arts in Michigan, held in Detroit last summer.

The company's production of Albee's "The Zoo Story" was presented at the Attie Theater in Gresham and drew the largest audience in the Attie's history.

THIS SPRING, The Lion Company will come to the campus of OCC, at the invitation of the administration of the Auburn Hills campus. And to kick off the season at OCC-AH, the company has chosen to present works by two of the most distinguished voices in the American theater today: Edward Albee and Stephen Sondheim.

"Music and/or Lyrics by Stephen Sondheim" is an original musical revue highlighting works by Broadway's most celebrated composer/lyricist. Sondheim is responsible for such musicals as "Follies," "Company," "A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum" and wrote lyrics for the songs to "West Side Story" and "Gypsy," among others.

The revue will feature performers who have worked with such organizations as the Michigan Opera, the Attie Theater, and the Somerset Mall Dinner Theater (Jimmy Launce Productions).

Following the opening of the Sondheim revue, the Lion Company plans a second gala opening the next night. The second presentation will be an evening of one-act plays by Edward Albee: "The Sandbox," "The Zoo Story" and "The American Dream." "The Zoo Story" will be a revival of the production presented at the Attie Theater, while "The Sandbox" and "The American Dream" will be new productions utilizing talents from the Oakland County area.

A complete schedule of performances will follow at a later date. Plays under consideration for future staging at OCC include Albee's Pulitzer-Prize-winning comedy "Seascape," Shakespeare's "A Midsummer Night's Dream," Joe Orton's "What the Butler Saw" and the current hit "Vanities."

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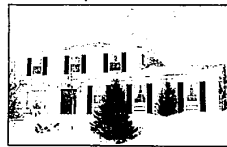
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
