Chicago's Melkin Puppet Theater joins the Easter Bunny's Mother for a special Detroit Youthcenter presentation of "Peter Rabbit's Easter Basket" on stage at the Detroit Institute of Arts Auditorium on Saturday, April 14, at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m.

One of Youthcenter's "Wiggle Club" shows for young people 3-8 years of age, "Peter Rabbit's Easter Basket" features a trilogy of favorite Beatrix Potter stories. Children younger than 3 will not be admitted.

An annual visitor to the Youthcenter stage, the Easter Bunny's Mother will greet young theater patrons in the theater lobby before the show and will take part in the "Wiggle Club" segment of the presentation.

Youthcenter's "Wiggle Club" is especially designed for first-timers to the theater, with two or three 10-20 minute segments which will hold the attention of the younger child. In addition, the theater is never completely darkened.
