

# HHS net coach banks on practice

With pre-season optimism about the boys' and girls' tennis teams he coaches. And this spring it appears that there is good reason for the high hopes he has for his boys' squad.

With its top seven players back from last season (8-5 overall and third in the Western Six League) and several promising newcomers, Harrison figures to be a contender for the WSL tennis title.

"I don't want to sound too optimistic, but we could be pretty good — if we ever get a chance to practice," said Goldstein, whose team missed a few days of school this week because of the power failure.

"We won't be too heavy on top, but we'll have good balance. For the first time in years we should have three good doubles teams."

Barry Leshman, a senior, should hold down the No. 1 singles spot at Harrison. Barry Sokol, also a senior, is another strong singles player. Juniors Dave McDevitt, Dave Hawthorne and Rick Kovan also have experience from last season.

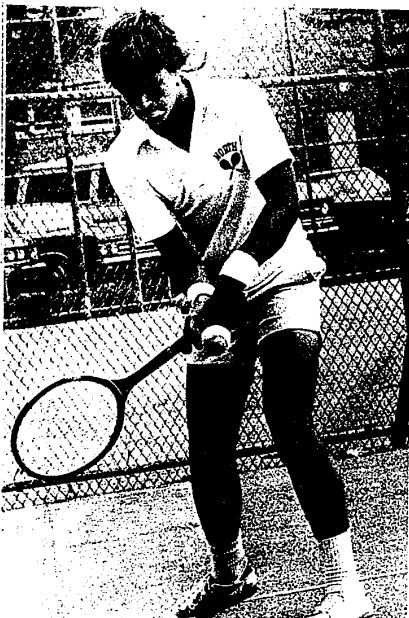
The No. 1 doubles team, seniors Al Laford and Mark Deikman, has been playing together for three years. Sophomores Mark Miller and Craig Shea will play at No. 2 doubles. Narendra Bhagat, a sophomore transfer from Chicago, and Andrea Berk figure to be strong in No. 3.

GOLDSTEIN HOPES his Hawks could improve on last year's finish in the Western Six League — third behind Northville High and Livonia Churchill. The title was the fourth-straight for Northville.

"The Western Six should be good this year," he said. "Northville isn't as strong and the rest of the teams are better. There could be four contenders — Northville, Harrison, Plymouth Cam-

ton and Waterford Mott." Harrison opens its season April 24 at home against non-league Detroit Catholic Central. On the next afternoon (April 25), Harrison entertains WSL foe Northville. North Farmington's tennis season is already under way. The Raiders dropped a 7-0 decision to Trenton on April 3. However, North's two best singles players, senior George Stroh and junior Mike Schupp, didn't play in the match.

Stroh and Schupp, who won the No. 3 singles title in the Northwest Suburban League last season, will be battling for the No. 1 singles spot this spring, according to coach Norm Stanislawski. "They're both strong competitors," he said. "If we don't get a chance to play them because of bad weather, then we'll decide about No. 1 through challenge matches."
