Film offers psychodrama

German director Rainer Werner Fassbinder's 1977 psychodrama "Chinese Roulette" will be shown by Detroit Film Theater on Friday, April 13.

Two showings will be offered, at 7 and 9:30 p.m. in the Detroit Institute of Arts auditorium. Tickets may be purchased in advance from the museum ticket office (832-2730) as well as at the door.

Called "...fascinating... hypnotic..." by the New York Times, "Chinese Roulette" deals with the delight of a tyrannical teenage girl in manipulating her self-absorbed, adulterous parents.

On Saturday, April 14, at 7 and 9:30 p.m., "Deep End," a 1977 English film explores the sexual yearnings of an experienced 15-year-old boy who works in a seedy public bath house in London. Critic Andrew Sarris called the film "a work of genius... the best of Godard, Truffaut, Polanski, and then some."

DFT's RETROSPECTIVE of the films of Orson Welles will feature 1949's "The Third Man," made in England. Welles' portrayal of the despicable drug trafficker, Harry Lime, was hailed by critic Andre Bazin as "a milestone in Welles' career." "Our good friends in the other Detroit media did an unprecedented job of helping us relay the message of the critical need for donations," added Futernick.

THE CHANNEL 56 Auction is the fourth biggest public TV auction in the country, with only New York, Boston and San Francisco raising more money. "The extremely hard work of our hundreds of volunteers is intrinsic to our success," Futernick said.

On hand to bring the fund-raiser to a close were General Chairman Joan Hicks, official host Marc Avery and a group of volunteers.

Mrs. Hicks, who has been a volunteer with the auction since its start 11 years

ago, has been general chairwoman for the last two years.

Noting the success of this year's auction, Mrs. Hicks said, "We added some new and very successful elements to this year's auction, including industrial items, high fashion and a well-received Art Day guided by community art experts."

Next year's auction general chairwoman is Barbara Hechtman, this year's vice chairwoman who has headed up the go-getters operation for two years. She has been volunteering for the auction the last six years.

Money raised by Channel 56 during the annual auction represents about 20 per cent of the station's operating budget of more than \$3 million.

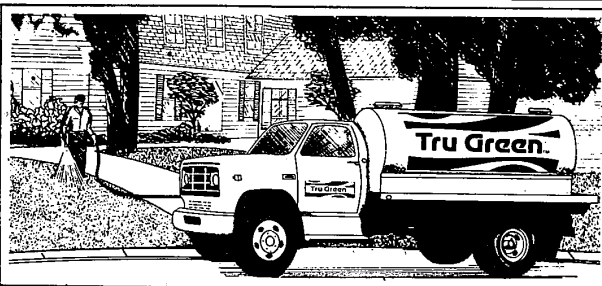
