WITH THE SUPPORT of the rest of the class, the Galens decided to explain to their children that they would be called to diamer once. If they didn't show up to eat by the time everyone else was finished eating, they were out of luck for that meal.

The next day, the Galens tried the Dreikurs' method suggestion. The children stayed outside after they were called and missed dinner.

"I knew they wouldn't starve. They wouldn't strived up," said Galen, a radiologist.

Although Galen's son and daughter were angry about being denied dinner, they managed to show up on time for the next evening's meal. "We haven't had any trouble since then," Galen said.
"My mother wouldn't have let me miss a meal," he added.
His mother probably wouldn't allow him to make his own breakfast when he was 4 years old, but Galen's son can and does make his own eggs in the morning.

Once when his mother was visiting, she suggested to her young grandson that he'd better skip making his own breakfast because he would make a meas.

"I told her, this is our house and he can make his own breakfast," Galen said.

It was one of the few times he has interceded in an argument conducted by one of his children.

TAKING PART IN HIS children's arguments is one of the things that Galen has learned to avoid through studying Dreikurs' method.

Fights between a brothers and sis-ters go on uninterruptted unless poten-tially physically harmful behavior be-comes part of the argument, according to Galen.

"When we first started that, the number of fights went down," Galen reported.

But poor behavior isn't left unnot-iced. If a child is behaving badly, Galen


