"IT WAS REALLY an accident," Gelfond said of his accomplishment. "I went to the bathroom before the race, and when I came back, I couldn't find my friends.

Neal Schechter of West Bloomfield, and Sheldon Bross and Murray Levin of Birmingham were all racing for the first time at Boston. Lou Milgrom of Franklin, and Simon Cook and Ronald Michaelson of Farmington Hills were all racing in their third marathon.

None are youngsters. Milgrom is 57, Schecter and Levin are both 49, Bross is 48, Cook is 44, and Michaelson is 36. And none were outstanding athletes in high school, according to Gelfond.
