## 2 Glen Riley gymnasts win state titles

Glen Riley's gymnastics school produced an individual state champion over the weekend at the Class III B meet at Grand Ledge High School near Lansing.

Rochester's Nikki Smith won the all-around championship in the 12-14 junior division of the two-day competition. She took a first-place gold medal on the uneven parallel bars.

According to Riley, there were more than 170 gymnasts who had qualified

for the state championships. He described it as the "biggest meet of the year."

Competition was divided into a children's and junior division.

In the children's division, Glen Riley's gymnasts took four of the first seven all-around positions.

The school was led by Becky Meredith, who took second place all-around. Meredith, from the Blokklands area of Avon Township, took a second-place

silver medal on the uneven bars, and tied for eighth place in the floor exercises.

Rochester's Lisa Rotondo tied for sixth on the vault, and finished sixth all-around. Colleen Otterson finished fifth all-around, taking second in floor exercises and seventh on the bars.

Missy Taylor tied for seventh on the bars, and tenth on the balance beam. She finished in a tie for seventh place all-around.

Sue Bouvier also had a good outing, and finished eighth all-around. She was eighth on the bars, and ninth off the vault.
