

Decoupeurs will gather in Dearborn

For the first time, the National Guild of Decoupeurs will hold its National Decoupage Exhibition in Michigan. The annual exhibit is supported by a grant from the Michigan Council for the Arts.

It will be open to the public on Friday, April 27, 10 a.m. to 10 p.m., and Saturday, April 28, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., at the Dearborn Inn, Dearborn. It will be held in conjunction with the seventh annual convention of the guild.

Every form of decoupage will be shown, with articles made by members throughout the country. There will also be special exhibits from the Decoupeurs' Guild of Ontario and from the New England Guild of Decoupeurs.

Of particular interest will be a dining room set made by Mrs. Elizabeth Suarez of Dearborn, and a miniature home, totally built by Mr. and Mrs. Armond Reid of Detroit.

A glass plate collection planned for the White House will also be on display. Other items will include furniture, wall hangings, lamps, screens, boxes, purses and how-to exhibits. Donation at the door will help support the education objectives of the guild.

The National Guild of Decoupeurs is a non-profit organization, incorporated in Michigan seven years ago. Members are dedicated to the preservation and study of the 300-year-old art. Michigan was the springboard for the formation of the guild, with one of its members, Mrs. James O. Hoyt of Grosse Pointe, a founder and the first president.

Museum depicts Polish heritage

Continuing a program of exhibits on Detroit's multi-ethnic heritage, the Detroit Historical Museum will open a display on "Detroit's Polish Heritage," April 28. Prepared in cooperation with the Friends of Polish Art, the exhibit will continue through Sunday, Oct. 14.

The exhibit committee is headed by Henryk Pawlowski, a local artist, and coordinated by Silvia Williams, urban history curator at the Detroit Historical Museum.

The committee has assembled materials reflecting the rich heritage of this large local community. The process of immigration, the role of church, home and school as well as social and fraternal organizations, traditions and culture in theater, song and dance, involvement in labor, commerce, professions and sports, and the influence of press and radio are some of the topics to be covered. Moreover, an extensive search for relevant materials goes on. The committee and the museum urge anyone with relevant documents or artifacts to contact the Historical Museum.

"We are anxious to display items that will offer visitors a glimpse into the rich and varied culture of Detroit's Polish-Americans," said Mrs. Williams. "Currently we have numerous photographs, books and booklets, clippings, tape recordings, art and folk art, and costumes and banners. However, anything which might enhance the exhibit will be appreciated."

The Historical Museum, in the Cultural Center at Woodward and Kirby, is open Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.; Wednesdays 1-9 p.m. and Sundays 1-5 p.m. The telephone number is 833-1805.


