The Michigan Bottle law, which went into effect in December, requires all soft drinks and beer containers sold, offered for sale or given to consumers in Michigan be returnable. This includes bottles (plastic and glass) and cans.

How can I tell if my hair dryer has asbestos in it?

Look down the nozzle of the dryer. If your dryer has an asbestos liner, you will see it. It is a grayish color and circles the nozzle.

Do NOT try to remove it yourself. That would only release the asbestos particles into the air. If you are not sure, call the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission and see if your model is listed. The toll free number is 800-638-6326.

## The lively needle How to pick a canvas

A picture is worth a thousand words, especially if it's painted on needlepoint canvas. Some are so tempting that they practically leap into your arms. And then you have to pay the bill. How do you know if you're getting your money's worth?

Hand-painted canvases are available in most needlepoint shops. In most cases, each shop has its own artists who work exclusively for that shop and do their own designing.

This is the most expensive way to go, but you don't see your own design duplicated in anyone else's living room. Shop different stores. The artists, their designs, and the look of the canvases will differ widely.

HAND-PAINTED kits with canvas, yarn, needle and instructions in one package do exist. But these are not widely available and are still expensive, though less so than a one-of-a-kind original. Production is necessarily limited by the time it takes to do the hand work and the cost reflects this.

Next to hand painting, the best results are obtained from silk screening. This is a type of stenciling with a different stencil or screen for each color used.

When well done, colors are very good, edges are sharp and the effect may be as good or better than hand

painting. Because some hand work is involved in the lining up of the stencils, the process isn't 100 percent mechanical and the cost can be lower.

THE CHEAP KITS are stamped with a hot wax transfer. This multi-color or picture is applied to canvas by a machine in one process. No hand work is required. The results may be good or awful depending on the materials used.

Some problems exist with hot wax transfers and, to a lesser degree, with silk screening. Watch for the design's straight lines. If the threads of the canvas being painted are not quite straight, the painting will appear straight even though it may cross several threads. But you won't be able to stitch it straight without some creative cheating.

Be sure that the unprinted canvas border around the design is large enough to allow it to be blocked. One inch is the absolute minimum, and the better to have 1½ inches.

LOOK FOR TINY details. They may be charming, but are there enough canvas threads for you to stitch them as they're drawn? Many canvas designers are not stitchers, and they paint what is pleasing to the eye instead of what can be stitched.

Read the kit directions before you buy. If they specify the half-cross stitch, watch out for low yarn volumes.

## Past smoking can endanger unborn

Pregnant women who smoke put their unborn babies at risk. So do women who've quit smoking, even before pregnancy.

New evidence from a major study indicates that a mother's past smoking has an effect on her later pregnancies. Financed by the National Institutes of Health, the study involved 50,000 pregnancies at 12 hospital centers.

Dr. Richard L. Naeye of Pennsylvania State University, director of the study, said it is not clear how long the effects of smoking continue after a woman quits.

As a result, he advised women who plan to have children to give up smoking as soon as possible, long before pregnancy.

Some aspects of the study, which involved collecting data over a ten-year period, are still being analyzed. However, some conclusions are available.

Past smoking in the mother is related to the presence of unusually large areas of dead tissue in the placenta, where the fetus is attached to the inside of the womb.

Smoking is also related to a condition called placenta previa, in which the placenta is attached too low in the womb. This can lead to dangerous complications throughout pregnancy and during the birth process itself.

Women who smoked throughout pregnancy, the study found, experienced premature separation of the placenta from the womb. Other adverse effects were spontaneous abortions, stillbirths, and premature births.
