SATURDAY, MAY 5

Birmingham-Bloomfield Art Association — Annual May Fair will be held Saturday and Sunday at the art association building, 1516 S. Cranbrook. More than 50 local and regional artists will be showing their best paintings, graphics, jewelry, photography, glass sculpture and more. A Sunday morning brunch, \$3 each, is open to the public. Hours are Saturday, May 5, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday, noon to 4 p.m.

Spring Arts Festival — will be held from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. in the University of Michigan Dearborn Fieldhouse. It is sponsored by the University Artists and Craftsman Guild. The fieldhouse is across the street from the Fairlane Town Center. The festival will continue on Sunday from noon to 5 p.m.

CONTINUING SHOWS

W. F. Mutaly Galleries — The graphic works of Martin Baroshian spanning the years 1951 to present will be on exhibit at the gallery from May 6-26. Baroshian is well-known for his intaglio etchings with works in many museums and private collections including the Boston Museum of Fine Arts and the Museum of Modern Art. The range of the show extends from his early works of the '50s starting with his "Armenian Period" to his recent "Surrealist Suite."

Detroit Institute of Arts — Noguchi's Imaginary Landscapes will be presented through Sunday, June 7. It will be retrospective of the 74-year-old artist whose design interests extend to furniture, theater and landscape for gardens, plazas and playgrounds. The show

combines examples of Noguchi's simple sculpture with models, plans of photographs of his internationally famous projects.

Emerson Unitarian Fellowship — The works of Rita Mach Skoczen will be shown through June 3. Included in the display are acrylics, prints and drawings depicting scenes of fields and barns, flowers and animals. The show will run from 9 a.m. to noon at 4230 Livernois in Troy.

Kochiplitz Gallery — A show of hand-carved carousel horses by master carver Marcus Charles Illions will be on display at this Rochester gallery through May 30. The opening will include a calliope and mime troupe performing on the sidewalk outside of the gallery at 115 E. Fort St. The collection belongs to Jon and Barbara Abbott of Clarkston. The couple, formerly from Southfield, collects circus and carousel trappings as well as the steeds. Gallery hours are Tuesday and Wednesday, noon to 5:30 p.m., Thursday and Friday, noon to 9 p.m. and Saturday, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Arwin Gallery — Its May show features an exhibition of oils and watercolors of well-known Detroit artist, Richard Jerzy. This will be his fourth one-man show at the gallery. An opening champagne reception to view his work and meet him will be held on Saturday, May 12, from 2 to 5 p.m. The exhibition will continue through May 25.

Austin Galleries — Original lithograph prints of American artist, Bruce Bomberger, will be on display throughout May. His color prints, "English Pubs," and "French Grocer Stores,"

will be featured at the gallery in Lakeside Mall, Sterling Heights. Gallery hours are 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily and noon to 5 p.m. Sunday.

Rubiner Gallery — Larry Zox painting exhibit is now going on. It will continue through May 31. The gallery is at 621 S. Washington in Royal Oak.

Artist Guild — An exhibit of print constructions by M. Murphy-Reed plus Geometrics and Recent Paintings by Guild members. The exhibit will begin May 8 and continue until June 16. The Artist Guild is at 32647 Franklin Road in Franklin Village.

Allen Rubiner Gallery — Recent paintings by Larry Zox of New York will be on display at the gallery through May 31. Zox has a one-man exhibition at the Whitney Museum of Art and is in the collections of the Museum of Modern Art, the Hirschhorn, and the Tate Gallery, London. Gallery hours are Monday-Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Included will be works by Frankenthaler, Agam, Miro, Jenkins, Vasarely and Appel. There will also be a "Collector's Corner" for beginning collectors. The gallery, closed Sunday and Monday, is at 24175 Northwestern, Southfield.

Fine Arts Gallery — An unusual show of paintings by Ronald Warnock is being shown at this Dearborn gallery in the Village Plaza. The artist is working in what he terms the Fusion Concept, joining two or more of the senses, arts or sciences. Albert Haze of Garden City created music that comes from behind the painting via an eight track recorder. The artist aims to involve the viewer emotionally in this awareness he is putting together. The show opens April 12. It runs to May 15, 23400 Michigan Ave., Dearborn.

Susanne Hilberly Gallery — Paintings by Lynda Benglis and Ron Gorchowsky will be on display at the gallery through May 12. Both are leaders in the

The majority of the gifts are prints by contemporary artists. The gallery is on the campus of Oakland University, Rochester.

Artisans Gallery — One-woman show of works by former Detroit artist Miriam Aston. Ms. Aston, who now lives in California, was the first woman admitted to the Scarab Club of Detroit. She is presented teaching at Claremont College in California. Gallery hours are Tuesdays-Saturdays, 9-9 p.m., 19656 West Ten Mile, East of Evergreen.
