

Cranbrook Festival to return

Tranquil sounds of baroque classical music soon will come alive at Cranbrook Festival '79.

In its 14th season, the musical week-end encompasses a wide range of musical talent. Three evenings of Mozart, Haydn and Bach will be presented at 8:30 p.m., May 10-12. Christ Church Cranbrook provides an appropriate setting for the soothing compositions.

Among the performers are the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra, the Boston Symphony Chamber Players, Wayne State University Chamber Choir and the Baldwin Wallace Brass Quintet. Also featured are soprano Kathryn Bouleyn, tenor David Britton, Susan Marsee, mezzo-soprano, and John West, bass.

The festival is sponsored by the Cranbrook Music Guild, Inc. It has a successful history of bringing classical artists into the community.

KNOWN IN THE Soviet Union, the U.S. Virgin Islands, South America and throughout the United States, the Boston Symphony is making its third appearance at Cranbrook Festival. The group is comprised of the principal string, woodwind, brass players and solo timpanist.

The Wayne State University Chamber Choir has won first place in world competition in Wales twice. The choir appears annually with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra. The choir will present a special program of baroque classical music with the Boston Symphony Chamber Players during the Mozart program on Thursday, May 10.

Making a first appearance at the festival this year is the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra. The group is under the direction of Dennis Davies and is the only full-time professional chamber orchestra in the country.

Under Davies' direction, the chamber was selected by the State Department to represent the U.S. on tours to Eastern Europe and the Soviet Union. The Saint Paul Chamber will be joined by Armando Ghitalla in an all-Haydn program on Friday, May 11. Ghitalla is the principal trumpet player of the Boston Symphony and a member since 1951.

The focus turns to Bach on Saturday, May 12. Combining talents, the Saint Paul Chamber and Wayne State University's Chamber Choir will be joined by four opera soloists.

The opera singers featured at the festival specialize in diversity. All have an extensive list of accomplishments and possess all of the characteristics of seasoned performers.

BRINGING THE WORLD of music closer to its audience, the festival provides an opportunity to hear a variety of baroque classical by world-renowned talents.

Appearing throughout the musical weekend is the Baldwin Wallace Brass Quintet. In its eighth appearance at the Cranbrook Festival, the group will provide a foretaste of each evening's performance with chiblis from the west porch roof of the church.

The Quintet consists of the principals of the Baldwin Wallace Choir which performs each year at the famed Berea Bach Festival, now in its 47th year.

AS A SPECIAL musical dessert, carillonneur Albert Gerkin, of the University of Kansas, will conclude this year's festival with a special free Sunday afternoon carillon recital of baroque music May 13 at 4 p.m.

Gerkin was originally scheduled to make his debut at the Cranbrook Festival last year, but his performance was delayed because of the refurbishing of the bells last season.

Many hours of hard work go into making the Cranbrook Festival possible. James Schneider, volunteer head of the festival since its inception 14 years ago, has devoted considerable time and energy to its success.

Although Schneider is retiring after this year, plans for the resumption of the festival are in the works. The new management will be announced during the 1979-80 season.

Schneider and his wife, Chris, are quick to point out that the festival is the work of a whole committee of dedicated volunteers. "We have had a fantastic committee, who have stuck with us through the years," Mrs. Schneider said.

The Schneiders ran through the list of committee members, praising each person for valor — Floyd Bunt, who handles transportation for the artists, for instance, Schneider said Bunt is driving in his van for practically the entire duration of the festival.

Jan Goekel, he said, sold program ads better than many a professional. Norman F. Wedal, treasurer, went quickly and effectively about his rather awesome duties, Schneider said.

Mrs. William T. Grossett and Mrs. Ernest A. Jones, Schneider said, "played a vital role in assuring the financial stability of the festival."

Those who served on the festival executive committee and will continue through the '79 festival are: Mrs. Schwartz, vice chairwoman; Wedal, treasurer; Mrs. Floyd Bunt, secretary; Mrs. Edward Lawrence, ticket chairwoman; Mrs. Goekel, advertising; and Mrs. Eugene L. Hartwig, patrons and reception.
