A governor's special commission that includes four Oakland County residents has recommended construction of a large, abstract sculpture on the pedestrian mall of the State Capitol complex in Lansing.

The commission salected a large of

six, which picked sculptor Michael Heizer to execute the work.

Among the 16 members of the Governor's Commission on Art in State Buildings are; Mrs. Eliot Robinson, art-ist and collector from Birmingham;

Balthazar Korab, architectural photo-grapher from Troy; Dr. Donald D. O'Dowd, president of Oakland Univer-sity, and George E. Gullen Jr. of the law firm of Gullen & Fitzsimmons, Rochester. Another member is Livonia architect Louis G. Redstone. Chairperson of the commission is Adrian N. Langius, retired state archi-tect.

Site preparation costs have been authorized by the state legislature. The work is to be done by the end of this



The Governor's Special Commission on Art in State Buildings was created in 1975. Gov. William G. Milliken established a commission of 14, later expanding it to 16.

The idea is new in Michigan, but gov-



The idea is new in Michigan, but governments elsewhere have similar programs. The federal government's General Services Administration allocates half of 1 percent of total building costs for art. Alaska, Hawaii, Illinois, Oregon, Texas and Washington allocate 1 percent. The City of San Francisco allocates 2 percent.
