

Have your clams and contribute, too

Clam eaters may order their Cherry-stones and contribute to research for a clam-related cure for cancer at the same time in Chuck Muer restaurants through Tuesday, May 15.

Muer said he will offer "Sister Arline Cherry-stone Clams" at nine of his restaurants in Michigan, Ohio, Pennsylvania and Florida.

Guests will be asked to pay 5 cents more for each clam, and Muer will match it, sending the 10 cents per clam

to Dr. Arline Schmeer, director of marine studies at the American Medical Center in Denver.

A Dominican nun, Sister Arline has made a 17-year study that shows a substance called mercenene found in Little Neck, Cherry-stone and Quahog clams — kills human cancer cells in tissue culture.

Muer said he has staged the benefit "because we love clams and serve more of them than anyone else around."

"Many seafood lovers believe that clams are a great health food, as well as being tasty. Now, Sister Arline's research is proving this scientifically," he said.

SHE EMPHASIZES, however, that eating clams is not recommended as a substitute for recognized medical treatment of cancer.
